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Vicentina Route

Rota Vicentina is a network of walking trails in SW Portugal. Comprising the Historical Way, the Fishermen's Trail, and several Circular Routes, totals 400 km to walk, between the city of Santiago do Cacém and the Cape St. Vincent, the south westernmost point in Europe.

Via Algarviana

Is a long-distance path for pedestrians running from Alcoutim in the Eastern Algarve all the way across the region from the far west on Cape St Vincent, near Sagres and crossing the Vicentina Coast Natural Park. The path has its origins in an ancient religious trail followed by pilgrims headed for the promontory of Sagres, where the relics of St. Vincent were found.
